DEPT A – HORSES

Saturday Sept 9 – Outdoor Arena

1. Pre-entry is encouraged but not required.

2. All rules governing Livestock Department as well as general rules and regulations governing the Garfield County Fair will apply to this department. General rules and regulations are available in the Fair Premium Guide.

3. Ages of all horses and exhibitors will be computed as of January 1st of the present year.

4. All horses must be shown in classes consisting exclusively of one breed. A separate program will be provided for Performance Classes.

5. Registration papers or copies must be shown to the Superintendent upon request.

6. NO EXHIBITOR will be permitted in or near the Judges stand or the P.A. System.

7. Ponies may be shown by adults as well as children.

8. No Stallions to be shown in youth classes.

9. No one in arena but exhibitors, judge and stewards.

10. If 2 or less entries per class, it shall be combined with the next age group in its category. Superintendents reserve the right to combine or cancel class if insufficient entries.

11. Exhibitors may enter one or more classes but each horse may have only one rider per class.

12. All horses will be judged by the Rules and Regulations of the American Quarter Horse Assn. unless otherwise specified.

13. Horses must have a current negative Coggins Certificate (dated with 12 months) in order to be eligible to show.

4-H & FFA Show Rules

1. Open only to those boys and girls who are bona fide members of Garfield County 4-H and/or FFA.

2. Horses do not have to be registered, but have been owned by the member or immediate family for 120 days before the show.

3. All breeds of horses including ponies will compete together in the 4-H & FFA show.

4. Each contestant may enter only two horses. Those horses must be shown and/or ridden by that contestant only. A contestant or a horse can not enter the same class twice.

5. Horses will be judged under the Oklahoma 4-H Horse Show Rules.
